ISSUES

TOWNSHIPS

Adams Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Adams Township for the purpose of **FIRE PROTECTION, FOR PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FIRE APPARATUS, APPLIANCES, BUILDINGS, AND SITES** at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.15 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Jackson Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Jackson Township (exclusive of the Villages of St. Paris and Christiansburg) for the purpose of **GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF ROADS AND BRIDGES** at a rate not exceeding 0.6 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.06 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Johnson Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Johnson Township (exclusive of the Village of St. Paris) for the purpose of **GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF THE STREETS, ROADS AND BRIDGES** at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Mad River Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Mad River Township for the purpose of **FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES** at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.05 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Rush Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Rush Township (exclusive of the Villages of Woodstock and North Lewisburg) for the purpose of **GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF ROADS AND BRIDGES** at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for three years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Union Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement) A replacement of a tax for the benefit of Union Township (exclusive of the Village of Mutual) for the purpose of **GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF ROADS AND BRIDGES** at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each one

dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.20 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Urbana Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Urbana Township (exclusive of the City of Urbana) for the purpose of **PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FIRE APPARATUS, APPLIANCE BUILDINGS OR SITE THEREFORE OR THE PAYMENT OF FIREMEN OR FIRE FIGHTING COMPANIES TO OPERATE THE SAME** at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Wayne Township – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Wayne Township for the purpose of **GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF ROADS** at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.15 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

VILLAGES

Mechanicsburg Village – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of Mechanicsburg for the purpose of **CURRENT EXPENSES** at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.15 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

St. Paris Village – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of St. Paris for the purpose of **PROVIDING AMBULANCE SERVICE, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE OR BOTH** at a rate not exceeding 1.3 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.13 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Woodstock Village – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of Woodstock for the purpose of **CURRENT EXPENSES** at a rate not exceeding 1.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.19 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

FIRE DISTRICTS

Johnson St. Paris Fire District – Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) An additional tax for the benefit of Johnson St. Paris Fire District for the purpose of **PURCHASE OF AMBULANCE EQUIPMENT, OR PROVISION OF AMBULANCE, PARAMEDIC, OR OTHER EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATED BY A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR FIREFIGHTING COMPANY** at a rate not exceeding 2.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.25 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Northeast Champaign County Fire District – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Northeast Champaign County Fire District for the purpose of **FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE** at a rate not exceeding 4.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.45 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for three years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Triad Local School District – Proposed Income Tax (Renewal) Shall an annual income tax of 0.5% on the school district income of individuals and of estates be imposed by the Triad Local School District to renew an income tax expiring at the end of 2010 for five years, beginning January 1, 2011, for the purpose of **PROVIDING FOR CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT?**

Mechanicsburg Exempted Village School District – Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Mechanicsburg Exempted Village School District for the purpose of **PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT** in the sum of \$189,000 and a levy of taxes be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 2.3 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.23 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of 5 years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Northeastern Local School District – Proposed Income Tax and Bond Issue Shall the Northeastern Local School District, Clark and Champaign Counties be authorized to do both of the following:

- (1) Impose an annual income tax of one-quarter percent (0.25%) on the earned income of individuals residing in the school district, for thirty-seven (37) years, beginning January 1, 2010, for the purpose of general permanent improvements, including paying the cost of locally funded initiatives for the District's classroom facilities project?
- (2) Issue bonds for the purpose of paying the local share of school construction under the State of Ohio classroom facilities assistance program in the principal amount of Sixty-Five Million Eight Hundred Forty-Four Thousand and Forty Dollars (\$65,844,040), to be repaid annually over a maximum period of thirty-seven (37) years, and levy a property tax outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the bond repayment period seven and five hundred seventy-two one-thousandths (7.572) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.7572 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

Northwestern Local School District - Proposed Income Tax and Bond Issue

Shall the Northwestern Local School District, of Clark and Champaign Counties, be authorized to do both of the following:

- (1) Impose an annual income tax of one percent (1.00%) on the earned income of individuals residing in the school district, for a continuing period of time, beginning January 1, 2010, for the purpose of current expenses?
- (2) Issue bonds for the purpose of paying the local share of school construction under the state of Ohio classroom facilities assistance program in the principal amount of Twenty-Eight Million Two Hundred Forty Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$28,240,110), to be repaid annually over a maximum period of twenty-eight (28) years, and levy a property tax outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the bond repayment period seven and thirty-six hundredths (7.36) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.736 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?
