NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

Gen'l Code, Secs. 4785-5.

The Board of Elections of Champaign County, Ohio, Issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election.

A SPECIAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON

or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of ²

Graham Local School District

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) Shall a levy be imposed by the Graham Local School District, Counties of Champaign and Shelby for the purpose of **EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT** in the sum of \$ 1,800,000 and a levy of taxes be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 8 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.80 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five years, commencing in 2011, first due in calendar year 2012?

Mechanicsburg Exempted Village School District

Proposed Income Tax (Renewal) Shall an income tax of 1% on the school district income of individuals and of estates be imposed by Mechanicsburg Exempted Village School District to renew an income tax expiring at the end of 2011 for five years, beginning January 1, 2012 for the purpose of **CURRENT EXPENSES?**

Northwestern Local School District

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Northwestern Local School, Clark and Champaign Counties, Ohio for the purpose of **GENERAL PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS** at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each on hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2011, first due in calendar year 2012.

Miami East Local School District

Proposed Income Tax (Additional) Shall an annual income tax of 0.75% on the school district income of individuals and of estates be imposed by the Miami East Local School District, for five years, beginning January 1, 2012, for the purpose of current expenses?

Polls for the Election will open at 6:30 o'clock A.M., and remain open until 7:30 o'clock P.M., of said day.
