NOVEMBER ELECTION DEADLINES APPROACHING

AUGUST 8, 2011 – The deadline to file declarations of candidacy for non-partisan offices to appear on the November 8, 2011 General Election ballot is Wednesday, August 10 at 4:00 PM. This deadline also applies to the filing of local questions and issues, including local options.

Non-partisan races in Clinton County to appear on the November ballot include a mayor and two council seats in the villages of Clarksville, Martinsville, Midland, New Vienna, Port William and Sabina; one trustee and fiscal officer position in each of the county's townships; and two school board seats in each of the county's school districts and any overlapping school districts from neighboring counties.

In addition to the non-partisan races, partisan races will also appear on the November ballot in the Village of Blanchester and City of Wilmington. Partisan races in Blanchester include mayor, two council seats, and two seats on the Board of Public Affairs. In Wilmington, partisan races include mayor, president of council, city auditor, city law director, three at-large seats, and one council seat in each of the four city wards. The party nominees for these offices were determined in the May 3, 2011 Primary Election. The deadline to file as an independent candidate for offices in both municipalities was May 2.
