

**PROCLAMATION
NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION**

The Board of Elections of Clinton County, Ohio issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election:

A PRIMARY ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, THE 4TH OF MARCH 2008 (the first Tuesday in March) at the usual places of holding elections in each and every precinct throughout said County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of choosing the following:

Delegate and Alternate to the National Convention for Democratic Party; Delegate-at-Large and Alternate-at-Large to the National Convention for Republican Party; District Delegate and District Alternate to the National Convention for the Republican Party; United States Representative to Congress 3rd District; Justice of the Supreme Court (full term commencing 1/1/09); Justice of the Supreme Court (full term commencing 1/2/09); Judge of the Court of Appeals 12th District (full term commencing 1/1/09); Judge of the Court of Appeals 12th District (full term commencing 2/9/09); Member of State Central Committee, Man 17th District; Member of State Central Committee, Woman 17th District; State Representative 86th District; Judge of the Court of Common Pleas Probate & Juvenile Divisions (full term commencing 2/9/09); County Commissioner (full term commencing 1/2/09); County Commissioner (full term commencing 1/3/09) Prosecuting Attorney; Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas; County Sheriff; County Recorder; County Treasurer; County Engineer; County Coroner; Republican Members of County Central Committee and determining the following Questions and Issues:

VILLAGE OF SABINA: Proposed RENEWAL tax levy Current Expenses, 1.4 mills, 5 years

VILLAGE OF MIDLAND: Proposed ADDITIONAL tax levy 3 mills for 5 years

GREENEVUE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT: Renewal, School Income Tax, 0.5%, 5 years

FAIRFIELD LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT: Proposed additional tax levy 4.5 mills, 4 years

MIAMI TRACE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT: Proposed bond issues for \$9,154,794 repay over 28 year period and \$3,000,000 repay over 28 years; Tax levies 2 mills for 28 years and 0.5 mill for 23 years
