

Notice of Election on Proposition R.C. 3501.11 (G)

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution of the Board of Education of the Miami Trace Local School District, Counties of Fayette, Clinton, Highland, Madison, Pickaway, and Ross, Ohio passed on the 7th day of August, 2007, there will be submitted to a vote of the people of said school district at the GENERAL ELECTION to be held in the Counties of Fayette, Clinton, Highland, Madison, Pickaway, and Ross, Ohio, at the regular places of voting therein, on the 6th day of November, 2007, the following questions as a single proposal.

- (1) the question of issuing bonds of said Board of Education in the amount of nine million, one hundred fifty-four thousand, seven hundred ninety-four dollars (\$9,154,794) for the purpose to pay the local share of school construction as an exceptional needs district under the State of Ohio Classroom Facilities Assistance Program as provided by law.
The maximum number of years during which such bonds are to run is 28 years.
The estimated average additional tax rate amounts to twenty cents (\$0.20) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, which is 2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, in excess of the ten mill limitation, as certified by the County Auditor.
- (2) the question of an additional levy of taxes for the benefit of the Miami Trace Local School District for the purpose of maintaining classroom facilities at the rate of one-half mill for each one dollar of valuation for a period of twenty-three years.
- (3) the question of issuing bonds of said Miami Trace Local School District in the amount of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing school facility improvements that are not included in the costs covered by the State of Ohio Classroom Facilities Assistance Program as provided by law.

The maximum number of years during which such bonds are to run is 28 years. The estimated average additional tax rate amounts to seven cents (\$0.07) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, which is .7 mill for each one dollar of valuation, in excess of the ten mill limitation, as certified by the County Auditor.

The polls for said election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
