

**LEGAL NOTICE**  
Pursuant to ORC 3505.13

The Clinton County Board of Elections is accepting bids for ballot printing for the 2010 Primary and General Elections.

Bids should be for an estimated 6,000 primary ballots and 13,000 general election ballots designed to run on the M-100 and M-650 scanning devices manufactured by Election Systems & Software, Inc. Ballot size is 17 inches with one 3 inch stub. Ballots are printed on two sides in black ink and will require sequential numbering, perforation and must meet all specifications set forth by the manufacturer of the M-100 and M-650 tabulation equipment.

In order to be considered, bids must meet all provisions of ORC 3505.13 and the bidder must meet the training requirements of the manufacturer of the tabulation devices.

Sealed bids shall be submitted to the Clinton County Board of Elections, to the attention of Elizabeth Hart, Director, 46 South South Street, 1st Floor, Wilmington, OH 45177 no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 5, 2010. The sealed bids will be opened at the regularly scheduled board meeting on Tuesday, February 9, 2010. The meeting begins at 8:30 AM at the board's office, 46 South South Street, Wilmington, Ohio.

The Clinton Count Board of Elections reserves the right to reject any or all bids. The Board of Elections may, in their discretion, reject bids on the basis of cost and/or past performance of the bidder on other contracts performed for the board.
