

NOTICE OF ELECTION ON TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION

R.C. 3501.11(G), 5705.19, 5705.25

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the City Council of New Carlisle, passed on the 5th day of December, 2011, there will be submitted to a vote of the people of said subdivision as a Primary Election to be held in the City of New Carlisle, Ohio, at the regular places of voting therein, on the 6th day of March, 2012, the question of levying a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the City of New Carlisle for the purpose of repairing, improving and replacing streets, said tax being an additional tax at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.20 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2012.

The polls for the election will open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on election day.
