Jan. 19	Secretary of State and boards of elections must send notice to candidates required to file annual campaign finance reports .....	3517.11
Jan. 29	<b>Annual campaign finance reports</b> must be filed by certain candidates, political action committees, caucus committees (legislative campaign funds) and political parties by 4 p.m. (last business day of January) detailing contributions and expenditures through Dec. 31, 2009 .....	3517.10
Apr. 12	Secretary of State and boards of elections must send notice to candidates to file pre-election campaign finance reports .....	3517.11
Apr. 22	<b>Pre-primary election campaign finance reports</b> must be filed by candidates, political action committees, caucus committees (legislative campaign funds) and political parties by 4 p.m. (12 days before the election) detailing contributions and expenditures through April 14 (20 days before the election) .....	3517.10
June 1	Secretary of State and boards of elections must send notice to candidates to file post-election campaign finance reports .....	3517.11
June 11	<b>Post-primary election campaign finance reports</b> must be filed by candidates, political action committees, caucus committees (legislative campaign funds) and political parties by 4 p.m. (38 days after the election) detailing contributions and expenditures through June 4 (the seventh day before the report is filed) .....	3517.10
July 20	Secretary of State and boards of elections must send notice to candidates required to file semiannual campaign finance reports.....	3517.10
July 30	Semiannual campaign finance reports must be filed by certain candidates, political action committees, caucus committees (legislative campaign funds), and political parties by 4 p.m. last business day of July detailing contributions and expenditures through June 30, 2010 .....	3517.10
Oct. 11	Secretary of State and boards of elections must send notice to candidates to file pre-election campaign finance reports .....	3517.11
Oct. 21	<b>Pre-general election campaign finance reports</b> must be filed by candidates, political action committees, caucus committees (legislative campaign funds), and political parties by 4 p.m. (12 days before the election) detailing contributions and expenditures from the last day reflected in the previous report through Oct. 13 (20 days before the election) .....	3517.10
Nov. 30	Secretary of State and boards of elections must send notice to candidates to file post-election campaign finance reports.....	3517.11
Dec. 10	<b>Post-general election campaign finance reports</b> must be filed by candidates, political action committees, caucus committees (legislative campaign funds), and political parties by 4 p.m. (38 days after the election) detailing contributions and expenditures through Dec. 3 (the seventh day before the report is filed) .....	3517.10

Jan. 21	Secretary of State and boards of elections must send notice to candidates required to file annual campaign finance reports .....	3517.11
Jan. 31	<b>Annual campaign finance reports</b> must be filed by certain candidates, political action committees, caucus committees (legislative campaign funds), and political parties by 4 p.m. (last business day of January) detailing contributions and expenditures through Dec. 31, 2010 .....	3517.10

Note: \*In some instances, the statutory deadline falls on a day when the offices of the Secretary of State and boards of elections are closed. In those instances, the deadlines are extended, pursuant to R.C. 1.14, to the next succeeding day when the appropriate office is open for regular business hours. The preceding dates reflect the extended deadline.
