

NOTICE OF ELECTION TO BE HELD

ISSUES

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to a petition entry filed with the Board of Elections of Ross County, there will be submitted to a vote of the electors of said precincts, at the General Election to be held at the regular place of voting therein, on the 3rd day of November, 2009, for the issues designated as follows:

Buckskin & Paint Twps., Ross County, Ohio

An additional tax for the benefit of Paint Creek Joint EMS/Fire District for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings or sites therefor, sources of water supply or materials therefor, the establishment and maintenance of fire alarms, the payment of firefighters, the purchase of ambulance equipment, and the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services, or any other reason permitted by O.R.C. section 5705.19(I) at a rate not exceeding 5.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty-five cents (\$0.55) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for continuing period of time, commencing in 2009, first due in calander year 2010.

City of Chillicothe, Ross County, Ohio

An ordinance to provide for an increase in the city income tax levied from 1.6% to 1.7%, directing that such increase be applied to the purchase, renovation and reconstruction of certain real property commonly known as the Carlisle Building for use as city offices and facilities.

The proposed law would:

1. Amend Sections 163.03, 163.08 and 163.16 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Chillicothe, Ohio, directing that the city income tax levied increase from 1.6% to 1.7% and further direct that the increase in funds be applied to the purchase, renovation and reconstruction of certain real property commonly known as the Carlisle Building for use as City offices.
2. Said amendment would terminate upon completion and payment in full of the project.

City of Chillicothe, Ross County, Ohio

An ordinance restricting the use of mobile speed enforcement vehicles and traffic law photo-monitoring devices and repealing ordinance number 151-07 and chapter 315 of the revised ordinances of chillicothe, ohio

(Proposed by Initiative Petition)

To enact an ordinance preventing the City of Chillicothe from using mobile speed enforcement vehicles and traffic law photo-monitoring devices in the City of Chillicothe.

This proposed law would:

1. Prevent the city of Chillicothe, including its various boards, agencies and departments from using photo-monitoring devices or mobile speed enforcement vehicles for the enforcement of a "qualified traffic law violation," unless a law enforcement officer is present at the location of the device or vehicle and personally issues the ticket to the alleged violator at the time and location of the violation.

2. Repeal Chillicothe ordinance number 151-07 and Chapter 315 of the Revised Ordinances of Chillicothe, Ohio, and prevent the City from enacting or enforcing any ordinance that conflicts with this proposal.
3. Prevent the City from contracting with a vendor for the installation of any traffic law photo-monitoring device or mobile speed enforcement vehicle if payment to the vendor is contingent on the number of tickets issued or fees collected.
4. Allow the violator of any traffic law violation, in any civil proceeding, to be entitled to the benefits of the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure, the Ohio Rules of Evidence and Title 23 of the Ohio Revised Code.
5. Allow the violator of any traffic law violation, in any administrative proceeding, to be entitled to the benefits of Title 119 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Rules of Evidence

Deerfield Twp., Ross County, Ohio

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Deerfield Township for the purpose of ambulance and emergency medical services at a rate not exceeding one and one half (1.5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifteen cents (\$0.15) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Deerfield Twp., Ross County, Ohio

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Deerfield Township for the purpose of fire protection, ambulance and emergency medical services at a rate not exceeding nine-tenths (0.9) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to nine cents (\$0.09) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Huntington Twp., Ross County, Ohio

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Huntington Township for the purpose of fire, ambulance and emergency medical services at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Jefferson Twp., Ross County, Ohio

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Jefferson Township for the purpose of maintaining township cemeteries, at a rate not exceeding one and one-half (1.5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifteen cents (\$0.15) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Liberty Twp., Ross County, Ohio

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Liberty Township for the purpose of maintaining and operating township cemeteries at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

Springfield Twp., Ross County, Ohio

An additional tax for the benefit of Springfield Township for the purpose of maintaining and operating cemeteries at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.

Village of Adelphi, Ross County, Ohio

An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of Adelphi for the purpose of Fire Protection at a rate not exceeding five (5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty cents (\$0.50) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2009, first due in calendar year 2010.
