

# PROCLAMATION NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

A **Special Election** will be held on **Tuesday, May 2, 2017** at the usual place of holding elections in for each of the below precincts in Clark County or at such places as the Board may designate. The **Board of Elections of Clark County, Ohio** issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election which provides the issues which will appear on the ballot.

## Questions or Issues on May 2, 2017 Special Election Ballot

### **Clark - Shawnee Local School District Proposed Bond Issue**

Shall bonds be issued by the Clark-Shawnee Local School District, Clark County, for the purpose of constructing and renovating school facilities and locally funded initiatives under the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program of the Ohio School Facilities Commission; furnishing and equipping the same; improving the sites thereof; and acquiring land and interests in land in the principal amount of \$37,273,542, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 37 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 5.3 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.53 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

#### **Precincts affected:**

CITY 1, split 2 only; CITY 2, split 2 only; CITY 8, split 2 only; CITY 12, split 2 only; CITY 14; CITY 15, split 2 only; CITY 16, split 2 only; BETH 6, split 2 only; T-1; T-2, split 1 only; T-3; T-4, split 1 only; T-5; T-6; T-7, splits 1 and 3 only; and T-8.

### **Greenon Local School District Proposed Bond Issue**

Shall bonds be issued by the Board of Education of the Greenon Local School District, Clark County, for the purpose of paying the local share of school construction under the State of Ohio Classroom Facilities Assistance Program and the cost of other improvements to school facilities, together with, as applicable, new construction, improvements, renovations and additions to school facilities, site development, as well as equipment, furnishings, site improvements, and all necessary appurtenances therefor in the principal amount of \$36,000,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 37 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 6.98 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to \$0.698 for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

GREEN 1, MR-1 split 1, MR-2, MR-3, MR-4, MR-5 split 1, MR-6, ENON 1, ENON 2,

### **City of Springfield Proposed Municipal Income Tax**

Shall the Ordinance providing for a 0.4 percent levy increase on income for the purpose of public safety and other operating expenses, street and other capital improvements for 5 1/2 years, effective July 1, 2017 be passed?

#### **Precincts affected:**

City 1 thru City 37, T-6, split 2 only, T-7, split 3 and 4 only, and T-8, split 2 only.

### **Village of Enon Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)**

An additional tax levy for the benefit of the Village of Enon for the purpose of providing and maintaining the operation of a police department at a rate not exceeding 5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.50 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.

ENON 1 & ENON 2

### **Yellow Springs Exempted Village School District Proposed Tax Levy**

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Yellow Springs Exempted Village School District for the purpose of AVOIDING AN OPERATING DEFICIT in the sum of \$915,000 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 7.0 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.70 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 8 years, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.

#### **Precincts affected:**

MR - 5 split 2 only
